Do you understand that when enrolled you become subject to military law and liable to obey such orders as may be given you in accordance with instructions for the Home Guard issued by the Army Council, and that should you, without reasonable excuse, absent yourself from any parade or duty duly ordered by your superior officer, you will be liable on summary conviction by a civil court, to a maximum penalty of a fine of £10 or one month's imprisonment, or both, but that, except when you are mustered to meet invasion or apprehended invasion, such instructions will only require you to give part-time service, and will not require you to live away from home? ... Yes.
9. Do you understand that your service in the Home Guard will be without pay? ... Yes.
10. Do you understand that in the event of your incurring a disability attributable to your service, any claim for compensation will be dealt with under the regulations for the time being in force for the purpose which provide in the case of death or after discharge for permanent disability the same terms as are applicable to private soldiers and their dependants? (There is also provision for disablement allowances during periods of temporary incapacity due to Home Guard service and during the periods prior to discharge in the case of permanent incapacity) ... Yes.
11. Do you understand that you now engage to serve in the Home Guard for a period not exceeding the duration of the present emergency, but that during that period your service may be terminated, in accordance with instructions issued by the Army Council, by competent authority at any time ... Yes.
